AWARDS AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS

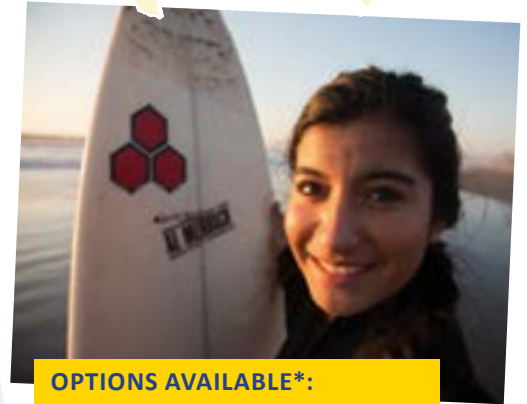
Monterey Bay Academy is part of the second-largest school system in the world and has been steadily outperforming the national average across all demographics.

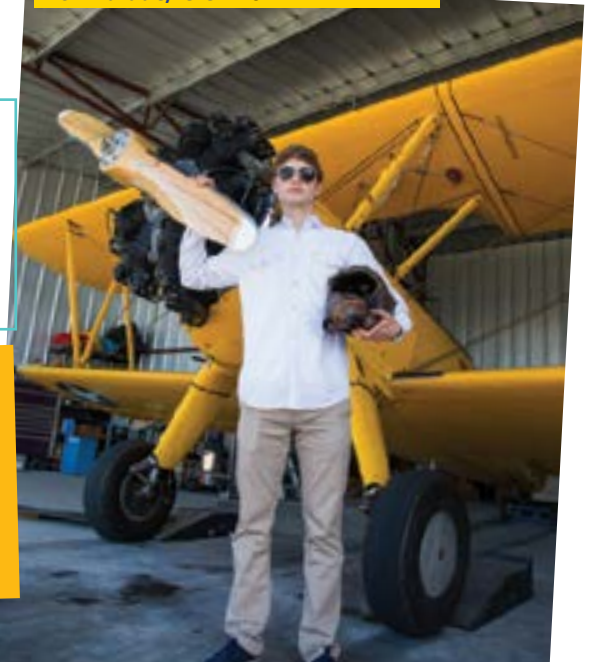
