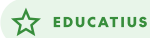

It offers a comprehensive academic curriculum that includes Advanced Placement (AP) courses and unique dual-enrollment programs with the University of Connecticut and Manchester Community College, allowing students to earn college credits while still in high school. Coventry High's mission is to prepare students not just for college, but for life in a rapidly changing world.

Facilities

The Coventry High School campus, modernized in a significant 2001 renovation, includes a state-of-the-art science wing, well-equipped computer labs, a library and media center, and an expanded gymnasium. These facilities provide students with access to the latest technology and resources they need to succeed. The school's large auditorium hosts performances, assemblies, and community events, while two courtyards offer quiet spaces for reflection and relaxation. The auxiliary gym and additional art studios also ensure that students can explore a wide range of extracurricular activities, from athletics to the arts.

Sports & Arts They Have and Excel In

Coventry High School is home to the Patriots, a proud member of the North Central Connecticut Conference (NCCC). The school offers 16 varsity sports, including soccer, volleyball, basketball, baseball, softball, cross country, and track and field. In recent years, the boys' baseball team won the CIAC State Championship in 2019, and the girls' volleyball team captured the state title in 2017, showcasing the school's competitive edge. Coventry also excels in the arts, with its award-winning band, choir, and visual arts programs. Students frequently perform in concerts, participate in art exhibitions, and are encouraged to develop their creative talents.
