State-of-the-Art Facilities

Recent investments have significantly enhanced the district's infrastructure. In June 2024, groundbreaking ceremonies marked the commencement of major upgrades at Clearfield and Layton high schools. Clearfield High is set to receive a new Career and Technical Education (CTE) building, a \$31 million project aimed at enriching vocational training opportunities. Similarly, Layton High is undergoing a \$32 million expansion, adding 14 new classrooms dedicated to performing arts, science, and family and consumer sciences.

Students have access to a wide array of sports, including soccer, basketball, track and field, and more, fostering teamwork and physical fitness. 
